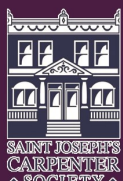

PUT A ON **FREEZE** **WINTER FIRES**

Home fires occur more in winter than in any other season. As you stay cozy and warm this winter season, **be fire smart!**

Half of all home heating fires occur in the months of



Keep portable generators outside, away from windows, and **as far away as possible from your home.**

Install and test carbon monoxide alarms at least **once a month.**



Have a qualified professional clean and inspect your chimney and vents **every year.**

Heating equipment **1** in every **7** is involved in reported **home fires** and **1** in every **5** home **fire deaths.**



Store cooled ashes in a tightly covered metal container, and keep it outside at least **10 feet** from your home and any nearby buildings.



Keep anything that can burn at least

3 feet from any heat source like fireplaces.



Plug only **1 heat-producing appliance** (such as a space heater) into an electrical outlet at a time.





Get into the groove of whatever daily life means to you and just "be here now." It's not a time to initiate brand new projects, but rather a time to check in with how you feel about current projects.

Regarding your diet, you may want to check whether you're eating enough fruits and vegetables.

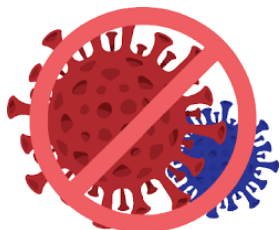

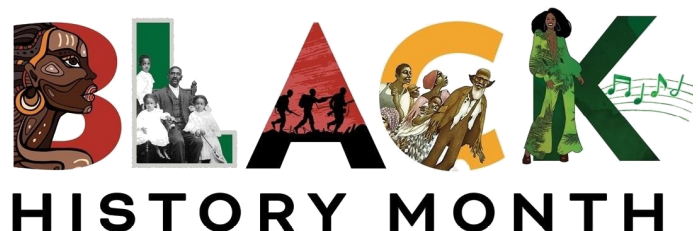

CHEWY CHOCOLATE COOKIES

INGREDIENTS

- 1) Cooking spray, for the pans
- 2) 3 c. confectioners' sugar
- 3) 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
- 4) 2 large eggs
- 5) 1 tsp. pure vanilla extract
- 6) 1 c. walnuts, chopped
- 7) 1/2 c. bittersweet or dark chocolate chips



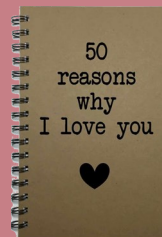
DIRECTIONS

- 1) Heat oven to 350 degrees F. Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper and lightly coat with cooking spray.
- 2) In a medium bowl, whisk together the sugar, cocoa powder, and salt. In a large bowl, whisk together the eggs and vanilla. Add the sugar mixture and mix to combine; fold in the walnuts and chocolate chips.
- 3) Spoon the batter (about 1 1/2 tablespoon per cookie) onto the prepared baking sheets, spacing them 2 inches apart. Bake, rotating the position of the pans once, until the cookies are puffed and the tops begin to crack, 12 to 14 minutes. Let the cookies cool on the baking sheets for 5 minutes, then slide the parchment and cookies to wire racks to cool completely.

Affordable Internet Connectivity Program



The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare and more. The benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10 a less than \$50 toward the purchase price.
