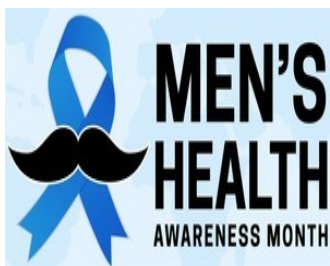

Ponga un alto al plomo permaneciendo 3 pasos por delante

Paso 1: Solicite la prueba!

Hable con el profesional médico de su hijo para que le haga un análisis de plomo en sangre. Un análisis de sangre es la mejor manera de determinar si un niño ha estado expuesto al plomo. Aunque el número de referencia de plomo en sangre de 3.5 identifica a un niño con niveles elevados en sangre, recuerde que **NINGUNA CANTIDAD DE PLOMO ES SEGURA.**

Paso 2: Programe una prueba de plomo en el hogar GRATUITA

Llame a Saint Joseph's Carpenter Society para programar una prueba de plomo en el hogar GRATIS al 856-966-8117 ext. 225. Si se encuentra plomo, usted puede ser elegible para recibir hasta \$13,000 en reparaciones para hacer que su casa sea segura contra el plomo.

Paso 3: Pase regularmente un trapeador húmedo por los suelos, las ventanas y los marcos de las ventanas.

Cuando la pintura vieja se quiebra y se descascara, produce polvo de plomo. El polvo de plomo es tan pequeño que no se ve. Los niños se envenenan con plomo al tragar el polvo de sus manos y juguetes.

El plomo no es seguro para nadie, pero los niños menores de 6 años son los que más riesgo corren. Si está embarazada, el plomo puede dañar a su bebé. Programe prueba de plomo en el hogar GRATIS hoy mismo.

Put a stop to lead by staying 3-steps ahead

Step 1: Request the test!

Talk to your child's healthcare provider about getting a blood lead test. A blood test is the best way to determine if a child has been exposed to lead. While a 3.5 blood lead reference number identifies a child with elevated blood levels, remember that **NO AMOUNT OF LEAD IS SAFE.**

Step 2: Schedule a FREE home lead test

Call Saint Joseph's Carpenter Society to schedule a FREE home lead test at 856-966-8117 ext. 225. If lead is found, you may be eligible to receive up to \$13,000 in repairs to make your home lead safe.

Step 3: Regularly wet-mop floors, windows, and windowsills.

When old paint cracks and peels, it makes lead dust. Lead dust is so small you cannot see it. Children get lead poisoning from swallowing dust on their hands and toys.

Lead isn't safe for anyone but children under 6 are most at risk. If you are pregnant, lead can harm your baby. Schedule your FREE home lead test today!

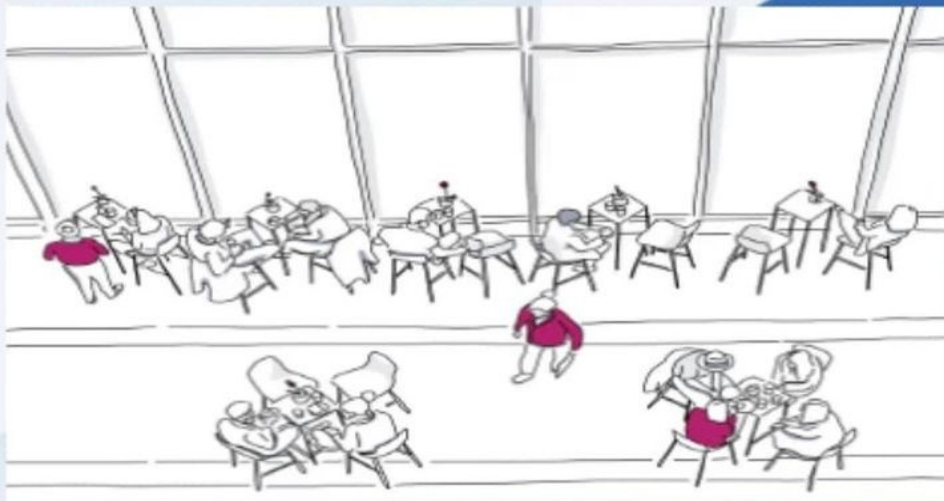
