
Paso 2: <u>Programe una prueba de plomo en el</u> <u>hogar GRATUITA</u>

Llame a Saint Joseph's Carpenter Society para programar una prueba de plomo en el hogar GRATIS al 856-966-8117 ext. 225. Si se encuentra plomo, usted puede ser elegible para recibir hasta \$13,000 en reparaciones para hacer que su casa sea segura contra el plomo.

Paso 3: Pase regularmente un trapeador húmedo por los suelos, las ventanas y los marcos de las ventanas.

Cuando la pintura vieja se quiebra y se descascara, produce polvo de plomo. El polvo de plomo es tan pequeño que no se ve. Los niños se envenenan con plomo al tragar el polvo de sus manos y juguetes.

Talk to your child's healthcare provider about getting a blood lead test. A blood test is the best way to determine if a child has been exposed to lead. While a 3.5 blood lead reference number identifies a child with elevated blood levels, remember that **NO AMOUNT OF LEAD IS SAFE.**

Step 2: Schedule a FREE home lead test

Call Saint Joseph's Carpenter Society to schedule a FREE home lead test at 856–966–8117 ext. 225. If lead is found, you may be eligible to receive up to \$13,000 in repairs to make your home lead safe.

Step 3: Regularly wet-mop floors, windows, and windowsills.

When old paint cracks and peels, it makes lead dust. Lead dust is so small you cannot see it. Children get lead poisoning from swallowing dust on their hands and toys.

Lead isn't safe for anyone but children under 6 are most at risk. If you are pregnant, lead can harm your baby. Schedule your FREE home lead test today!





Peanut Butter Chippers

Prep: 10 min. Bake: 15 min./batch Makes 3-1/2 dozen



Ingredients

6 tablespoons butter, softened

1/4 cup peanut butter

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup packed brown sugar

1 large egg

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1-1/4 cups all-purpose flour

1/2 teaspoon baking soda

1/4 teaspoon salt

1 cup milk chocolate chips

Directions

In a small bowl, cream the butter, panut butter and sugars until light and fluffy. Beat in egg and vanilla. Combine the flour, baking soda and salt: gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well. Stir in chocolate chips.

Drop by tablespoons 2 inches apart onto ungreased baking sheets. Bake at 350 degrees for 11-14 minutes or until golden brown. Remove to wire racks.






